



North Wales Police are advising that the current drop in temperature is forecast to continue with road conditions across the Force area expected to be affected by snow over the weekend for possibly three to four days.

A drop in temperature is forecast from Friday evening between +1° and -5° (With wind chill factor -3° to -15°) possibly causing roads to become icy. To compound the possible hazardous conditions, from 21:00hrs Friday 26th November through to the morning of Tuesday 30th November there is a 85% to 93% chance of snow fall across the whole of the North West/North Wales region.

North Wales Police are advising you to take extra care, prepare your vehicles, only drive when necessary and allow plenty of extra time for journeys.
